There is no additional fee, and you can swim workouts wherever you want. The benefit

For those swimmers age 50 and over, we have a USMS-recognized meet on Saturday, September 14, sponsored by Wisconsin Senior Games. The deadline for entry is Fri, September 6.

### **Wisconsin Swimmers Shine in Open Water Nationals**

This year two USMS open water National Championships were held in nearby Stillwater, Minnesota on Square Lake. Truly a National Championship, swimmers came from several U.S. states. Wisconsin held it's own, with Rachel Werking (pictured here) winning the overall Womens Division (ninth place overall), and with six Division first place finishers who are National Champions.

#### **Another Swim, Another Lesson**

I like to tell swimmers whom I work with that every failure is a lesson. I swam the National Championship 5K swim, and I messed up. Sort of. The course was two turns around a rectangle. Turning for the second lap, I intentionally veered to my left, and then started heading (unintentionally) for the third buoy. A boat came by with people pointing across the lake. "I'm okay," I said, pointing to the third buoy. Finally, they said, "You need to go to that buoy," pointing to the second one waaaay over there. I had sighted on the wrong buoy and added about 500 yards to my brilliant 5K swim. I might have come in second instead of third. Not a big deal, but I can tell you this: The next swim I will make sure I'm headed in the right direction.



## **Coaches' Recaps Short Course Nationals**

#### **Dave Clark, Fred Russel (Head Coaches)**

What a great meet! Overall we were #2 in the country collecting 1,489.83333 points. (Please don't make me explain the weird fraction.) Wisconsin was only 90 points behind a much larger Illinois (1,579.5) contingent, but ahead of Indiana and Michigan, who again were much larger. The (54) WISC Men were the best in the country (795.5 points), while the (41) Wisconsin Women placed 6th overall with 542.3 points. With so many championship swims and great relays, we crushed it!

National Champions in the Mens division are: Dean Fochios 200 free, Tyler Hines 50 back, Andrew Babcock 100 fly.

National Champions in the Womens division leading the way in individual scoring is Jenny Holtzen as National Champion in six individual events! 500 Free, 400 IM, 200 IM, 100 Breast, 200 Breast, and 200 Free. Wow and congrats!

The other individual National Champions include **Laurie Alioto** in the 400 IM and 200 Fly, **Anne Berris-Olivotti** in the 1,000 Free and **Jane Dillion Stewart** in the 200 Back.

Joining as Relay National Champions were the 65+ 200 Medley team of **Katie Mering**, **Ann Berres-Olivotti**, **Julie VanCleave** and **Laurie Alioto**.

# **Great New Tradition: Wisconsin Open Water Swim**

Editors' Note: Over the past few years, we've lost two good open water swims in Wisconsin (Madison Open Water and Big Swell). In a state with so many lakes, this has been a disappointment. However, you can't just plop down a swim meet in some lake. Open Water swims take a lot planning and work to put on. Jennifer Vallo and Mary Schneider, along with help from Lauren Jensen McGinnis and others, have staked out a new venue for those who like to swim to the buoys. I hope this event will grow for many years.

Here is Mary's report.

June 15 was a beautiful morning with mild weather and water temperature around 75 degrees. Volunteers and swimmers were ready for the second Wisconsin Open Water Swim, held at Fox Brook Park in Brookfield. This was the only USMS sanctioned open water event in Wisconsin.

This year featured 1000 and 1500 meter swims, separated by wetsuit and non-wetsuit events. There were 54 swimmers registered for the event, and 49 who swam. We attracted swimmers mostly from Wisconsin and Illinois, with 2 from other states.

The course circuit was 500 meters, so swimmers either swam 2 laps or 3. Some swimmers were very competitive, with a few non-wetsuit swimmers coming in around 21 minutes, and were actually faster than the wetsuit swim-



mers! Dave Watts, a Wisconsin Masters swimmer, was first overall in the 1000 meter wetsuit division, with a 17:44.90, and is one of our 70+ swimmers. This confirms as swimmers, age is not a factor!

Post swim, snacks were available, and awards were handed out, as well as a few raffle prizes. Swimmers enjoyed the event, and we hope many will return next year.

Special thanks to **Lauren Jensen McGinnis** and <u>TriFaster</u> for working as our excellent safety crew. Also, thanks to all the volunteers, both on the water and on land for additions to the safety crew, handing out registration packets, arm marking, bag check, and snack table assistants.
